## VILLAGE OF DORCHESTER BOARD MEETING

## DATE: APRIL 18 (Tuesday), 2017, immediately following Organizational Meeting Clerk's Office, 228 W. Washington Ave, Dorchester WI

## Minutes:

- 1. Meeting was called to order at 7:17pm.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.
- 3. The following Board members were present: President Rau, Trustee Underwood, Trustee Edblom, Trustee Schauer, Trustee Derrico, and Trustee Schwoch. Trustee Seubert was absent. Also present: Kevin O'Brien from T/P Printing, Darrell Steen, Justin Duranceau, and Josh Edwards.
- 4. There was no Public Input.
- 5. Darrell Steen spoke to the Board about paving options for Willow Court, Prospect Street, and Marsh Avenue. He asked if the money from TIF #2 has paid for curb & gutter in other areas of the Village. The cost estimate for only paving is \$85,000, plus an additional \$15,000 for catch basins; if curb & gutter are added, the project could cost as much as \$375,000.
- 6. A motion was made by Trustee Schauer, seconded by Trustee Edblom, to publish an ad in the Tribune-Phonograph and the Shopper for 2 weeks for part-time seasonal help for public works. Motion carried, 6-0.
- Discussion was held on financing options for the purchase of Bobcat backhoe from Swiderski Equipment Inc. A motion was made by Trustee Schwoch, seconded by Trustee Derrico, to go with Advantage Community Bank for a 5-year note with semiannual payments. Motion carried, 5-1, with Trustee Schauer dissenting.
- 8. A motion was made by Trustee Schauer, seconded by Trustee Derrico, to approve the purchase of manhole risers from Neenah Foundry Company at a cost of \$1,149 plus shipping & handling for E. Business County A. Motion carried, 6-0.
- A motion was made by Trustee Schauer, seconded by Trustee Schwoch, to purchase hanging flower baskets for light poles at an estimated cost of \$620. Motion carried, 6-0. Donations from area businesses totaling \$500 have been received toward the baskets so far.
- 10. President Rau announced the dates for Open Book and Board of Review: Open Book is on Thursday, May 4, 2017, from 3pm-5pm. BOR will be on Monday, May 15, 2017, from 6pm-8pm.

- 11. The next Village Board meeting will be on Wednesday, May 3, 2017, at 7pm.
- 12. A motion was made by Trustee Schauer, seconded by Trustee Schwoch, to adjourn. Motion carried, 6-0. Meeting adjourned at 8:33pm.
