

CHARTER ORDINANCE AMENDMENT # 158

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF CONSTABLE UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 61 and CHAPTER 66, WISCONSIN STATUTES.

The Village Board of the Village of Dorchester do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF INTENT.


It is the intention of the Village Board of the Village of Dorchester to abolish the position of Constable inasmuch as the Chief of Police, duly appointed by the Village of Dorchester, is to have the duties of the constable as required by law.

SECTION 2. ABOLITION OF CONSTABLE POSITION.

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 61.195 and Wisconsin Statutes 66.01, the position of Constable is hereby abolished as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
