

ORDINANCE NO. 210

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE ELECTION OFFICIALS  
TO WORK PARTIAL DAYS

The Village of Dorchester, pursuant to its authority in Sec. 7.30 Wis. Stats., does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Village Clerk shall have the following authority:

- (a) To establish working hours for different election officials assigned to the same polling place;
- (b) To select two (2) or more sets of election officials to work at different times on each election day; and
- (c) To establish different working hours for different duly appointed election officials assigned to the same polling place.

SECTION 2. If political parties submit lists to the Village for appointment of election officials pursuant to Sec. 7.30 (4) (c) Wis. Stats., the Village Clerk shall choose election officials in such a manner that the total number of officials is an odd number.

SECTION 3. Severability. The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the Ordinance. The remainder of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other Ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
