ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF TRAILERS AND MOBILE HOMES AND ESTABLISHMENT OF TRAILER PARKS AND MOBILE HOME PARKS

The Village Board of the Village of Dorchester, do ordain as follows: In order to protect and promote the public health, morals and general welfare of the community, and to lessen congestion on the streets; to secure safety from fire, panic and other dangers; to provide adequate light and air; to prevent the overcrowding of land; to avoid undue concentration of population; to facilitate the adequate provision of transportation, water, sewer, schools, parks, and other public requirements;

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, trust, partnership, association, or corporation to park a trailer or mobile home, or to establish a trailer park or mobile home park within the limits of the Village of Dorchester, without first informing the Village Board where the trailer or mobile home is to be parked, or trailer park or mobile home park is to be located and receiving from the Village Board a permit which is to be issued by the Village Clerk for such parking or locating of such parks. Any trailer or mobile home now parked in the Village limits may continue to remain so parked at such location, but if the same is not lived in for a period of six months, or is moved from the location which it now occupies, the trailer or mobile home shall not again be parked within the Village of Dorchester limits without complying with this ordinance.

Any person, firm, trust, partnership, association, or corporation who fails to comply with any provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof forfeit not less than \$25 nor more than \$100, together with the costs of prosecution for each violation, and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in the county jail of Clark County, Wisconsin, until payment of such forfeiture and costs, but not exceeding 30 days.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
