

The Common Council of the Village of Dorchester, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. (Direct Annexation) In accordance with S. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1966, and the petition for direct annexation filed with the Village of Dorchester Clerk on the 12 day of May, 1974, signed by a majority of the electors residing in the territory and the owners of one-half of the land in area and real property in assessed value in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Mayville, Clark County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Dorchester, Wisconsin:

The Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty-nine (29), North, Range One (1), East, except the East 275 feet of the North 696.25 feet of said Section 13, Township 29 North, Range 1 East, Clark County, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1. shall be a part of the Village of Dorchester for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the Village of Dorchester.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provisions of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
