## ORDINANCE NO.\_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE LOCATION OF BURIED FUEL TANKS IN RELATIONSHIP TO VILLAGE WELLS.

BE IT, HEREBY, ORDAINED, by the Village Board of the Village of Dorchester, Clark County, Wisconsin, as follows:

Section 1 - Location of Buried Fuel Tanks. No buried fuel tanks shall be located within 1,000 feet of any village well. This restriction shall pertain to all buried fuel tanks regardless if such tanks are used for residential, commercial, industrial, or any other purpose. This restriction shall also apply regardless of the substance that may be in such buried fuel tank.

Section 2 - Removal and Disposal. The owner of the property upon which a buried fuel tank is located shall be responsible for the removal and disposal of the tank.

Section 3 - Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. All previous ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
