

ORDINANCE No. 108

THE VILLAGE OF DORCHESTER DOES ORDAIN, AS FOLLOWS:

I. There shall be stop signs located in the Village of Dorchester limits for automobile traffic, as follows:

- (1) At the Northeast corner where Washington Avenue joins Fourth Street.
- (2) At the Southwest <sup>corner</sup> and at the Northeast corner where Washington Avenue crosses Second Street.
- (3) At the Northwest corner and at the Southeast corner where Center Avenue crosses Fourth Street.
- (4) At the Northwest corner and at the Southeast corner where Center Avenue crosses Third Street.
- (5) At the Northwest corner and at the Southeast corner where Center Avenue crosses Second Street.
- (6) At the Northwest corner and at the Southeast corner where Center Avenue crosses Front Street.
- (7) At the Southeast corner where Linden Street joins Center Avenue.
- (8) At the Northwest corner where Cannery Street joins Center Avenue.
- (9) At the Northwest corner where Hollman Road joins Center Avenue.
- (10) At the Northeast corner where First Avenue joins Fourth Street.
- (11) At the Northwest corner and at the Southeast corner where First Avenue crosses Third Street.
- (12) At the Northwest corner and at the Southeast corner where First Avenue crosses Second Street.
- (13) At the Southwest corner where First Avenue joins Front Street.
- (14) At the Northeast corner where Second Avenue joins Fourth Street.
- (15) At the Northwest corner where Third Street joins Second Avenue.
- (16) At the Northwest corner where Second Street joins Second Avenue.
- (17) At the Southwest corner where Front Street joins Second Avenue.

All stop signs will be of material according to standards set by the State of Wisconsin, and shall be located so as to be clearly visible by the approaching motorist.

II. There shall be located at the Southwest corner where Second Avenue joins Linden Street a yield-right-of-way sign, of material according to standards set by the State of Wisconsin, and shall be located so as to be clearly visible by approaching motorists.

III. All ordinances hretofore enacted in conflict with this ordinance are repealed. This ordinance shall be in force and effect following its publication.
