

Ordinance No. 187

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DISPOSAL OF GRASS AND YARD WASTE

The Village Board of the Village of Dorchester does hereby ordain as follows:

- A. DEPOSIT OF GRASS AND YARD WASTE. No person shall deposit, or cause to be deposited, by raking, carrying, blowing or any other method, any grass clippings or yard waste which are taken or removed from his/her premises, or elsewhere, upon any sidewalk, alley, parkway, public street or public place in the Village of Dorchester. Grass clippings or yard waste shall not be piled at or near intersections so as to obstruct the view of pedestrians or operators of motor vehicles.
- B. PENALTY. In any case where the owner, occupant, or person in charge of any yard shall fail to properly dispose of the grass and yard waste as set forth above, the Village may impose a penalty providing that the person who violates any of the provision above shall forfeit and pay to the Village of Dorchester a forfeiture of \$50.00 for the first such violation and a forfeiture of \$75.00 for the second and each subsequent violation. A separate violation shall be deemed committed during each day (24 hours) during which the violation continues.


Passed at a regular session of the Village Board this 6th day of July, 2004.
