

RESOLUTION OF VILLAGE BOARD ACCEPTING PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, a petition for direct annexation of the following territory of the Town of Mayville, Clark County, Wisconsin, to the Village of Dorchester, Wisconsin was filed with the Village Clerk on May 5, 1974:

The Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township Twenty-nine (29), North, Range One (1), East, except the East 275 feet of the North 696.25 feet of said Section 13, Township 29, North, Range 1, East, Clark County, Wisconsin;

WHEREAS, the clerk, and attorney have investigated said petition and certified to the Village Board that it was signed by a majority of the resident electors and the owners of at least one-half of the real property in assessed value in the territory proposed for annexation as of the date of filing of the petition and that the territory to be annexed is properly described in the petition and shown on the sale map attached thereto, is continguous to the Village of Dorchester and is unincorporated;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Village Board of the Village of Dorchester, Wisconsin, determines that the petition for annexation of the above described territory is a sufficient and legal petition conforming with the requirements of S. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

RESOLVED, That the petition be and is hereby accepted; and that the Village clerk is hereby directed to notify the clerk of the town of Mayville, of this resolution of acceptance in accordance with S. 66.021 (5) (a), Wisconsin Statutes.
