A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A METHOD FOR THE VILLAGE OF DORCHESTER TO BILL AND CHARGE FOR WATER-RELATED FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES.

As per Schedule Upf-1 - Amendment 7

The Village Board of the Village of Dorchester does resolve as follows:


WHEREAS, 1987 Wisconsin Act 339 created Section 196.03(3) (b), Wis. Stats., which created a duty for municipalities or their water utilities to make a specific decision in regard to billing for water-related fire protection service costs whether or not they wish to make any change at this time; and


WHEREAS, the law took effect on August 1, 1988;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Dorchester determines that this municipality and the Water Utility will continue to bill and pay for water-related fire protection services in the same manner as these services have been billed and paid for in the past until this body adopts a subsequent resolution changing the method of billing and paying for these services. It is understood that any billing for these services on customers' water bills as allowed by law must be approved (by resolution of this body) and by the Public Service Commission before the billing can be commenced.
