COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Dorchester, in cooperation with Clark County agrees to further participate in the preparation of the *Clark County Comprehensive Plan* for the general purpose of guiding and accomplishing coordinated, adjusted, harmonious development within Clark County and the Village of Dorchester.

AND WHEREAS, the Village Board of Dorchester, acknowledges the requirements of Wisconsin's Smart Growth Legislation, Wisconsin Statute Section 66.1001, the benefits of comprehensive planning, and that funding has been awarded by the Wisconsin Department of Administration to financially assist the County in preparation of the Comprehensive Plan;

AND WHEREAS, the development of the Clark County Comprehensive Plan does not require a financial contribution from the Village of Dorchester.

AND WHEREAS, a series of 8 regional meetings have been recently held throughout Clark County by County planning staff and their consultant which discussed the planning process and community planning process;

AND WHEREAS, as part of participating in the Clark County planning process the Village of Dorchester will receive an individual planning document for review which addresses the requirements as specified under WI's Smart Growth Legislation, (Section 66.1001).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of Dorchester hereby agrees to participate in the development and adoption of the Clark County Comprehensive Plan in cooperation

with other communities within their region and Clark County Pursuant to Wisconsin Statute Section 66.1001.
