

## RESOLUTION 210

### RESOLUTION FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION AIDS

WHEREAS, Village of Dorchester is interested in acquiring or developing lands for public outdoor recreation purposes as described in the application; and

WHEREAS, financial aid is required to carry out the project;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village of Dorchester (Dorchester Park Commission) has budgeted a sum sufficient to complete the project, and

HEREBY AUTHORIZES Ron Robida - President of Dorchester Park Commission to act on behalf of the Village of Dorchester to:

Submit an application to the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for any financial aid that may be available;

Sign documents; and


Take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the approved project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village of Dorchester will comply with state or federal rules for the programs; may perform force account work; will maintain the completed project in an attractive, inviting and safe manner; will keep the facilities open to the general public during reasonable hours consistent with the type of facility; and will obtain from the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources or the National Park Service approval in writing before any change is made in the use of the project site.
